**Please Note:** All supplies are for the individual purchasing them. Should they need to be replenished, it is up to the individual to do so to insure that they do not run out, i.e. pencils, tissues, paper are not shared items.

- 6 - Black and white composition books (college ruled)
  - 2 – journaling

- 2 3-ring binders
  - 1 white – to store Math worksheets
  - 1 – with dividers/tabs and pockets
    - to store completed writings

- Loose-leaf paper (college ruled-500 sheets)
- One (1) box of colored pencils (12 or more)
- Colored markers – broad tipped

- One (1) pair of somewhat larger scissors (not large adult size)

- 10 - #2 pencils
